Note: IE11 only works with WIN7 and WIN8, and since we are not yet claiming support for WIN8, users will need to use an IE11/WIN7 combination.



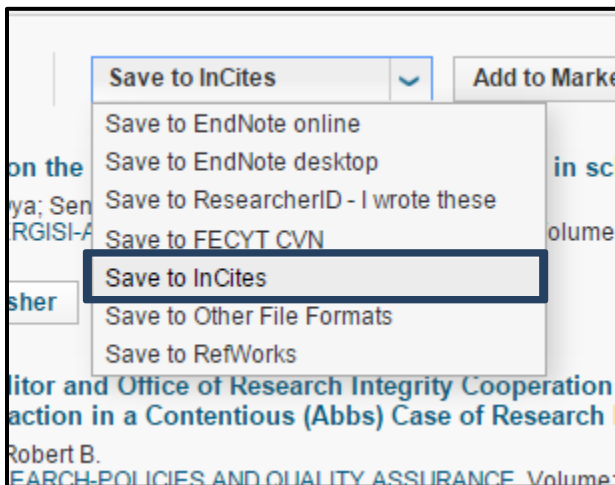
## ANALYZE CUSTOM DATASET VIA WEB OF SCIENCE TO INCITES

Web of Science and InCites are now integrated so users can send a results set from Web of Science to InCites, creating a custom dataset in InCites. For example, an administrator can use Web of Science to find top papers for a specific topic from particular institutions or a specific researcher and then save those records to InCites for analysis.

This feature allows records from 1980 forward to be sent to InCites. Users will be able to output up to 50K from Web of Science Core Collection search results and 5K records from the Marked List.

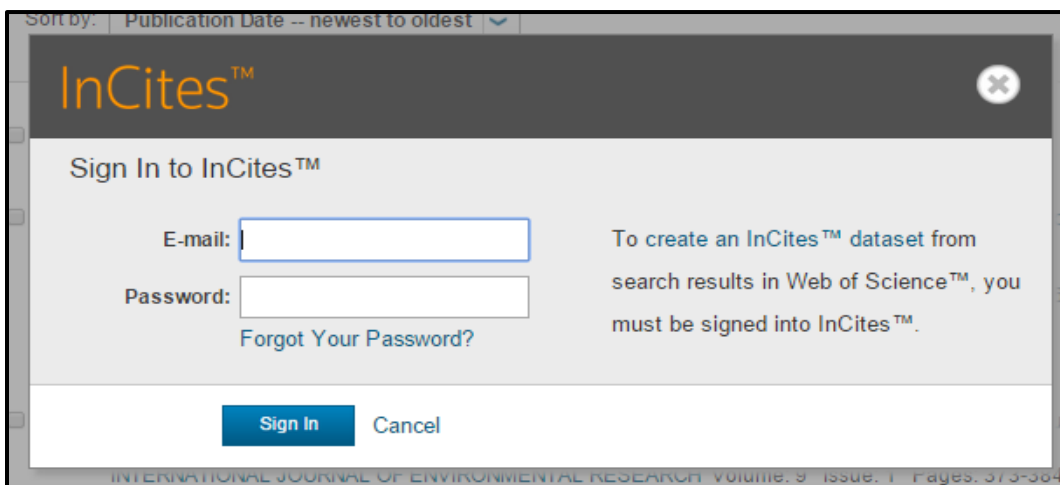
**Note:** This output option will appear to all users, but only InCites subscribers will be able to use it.

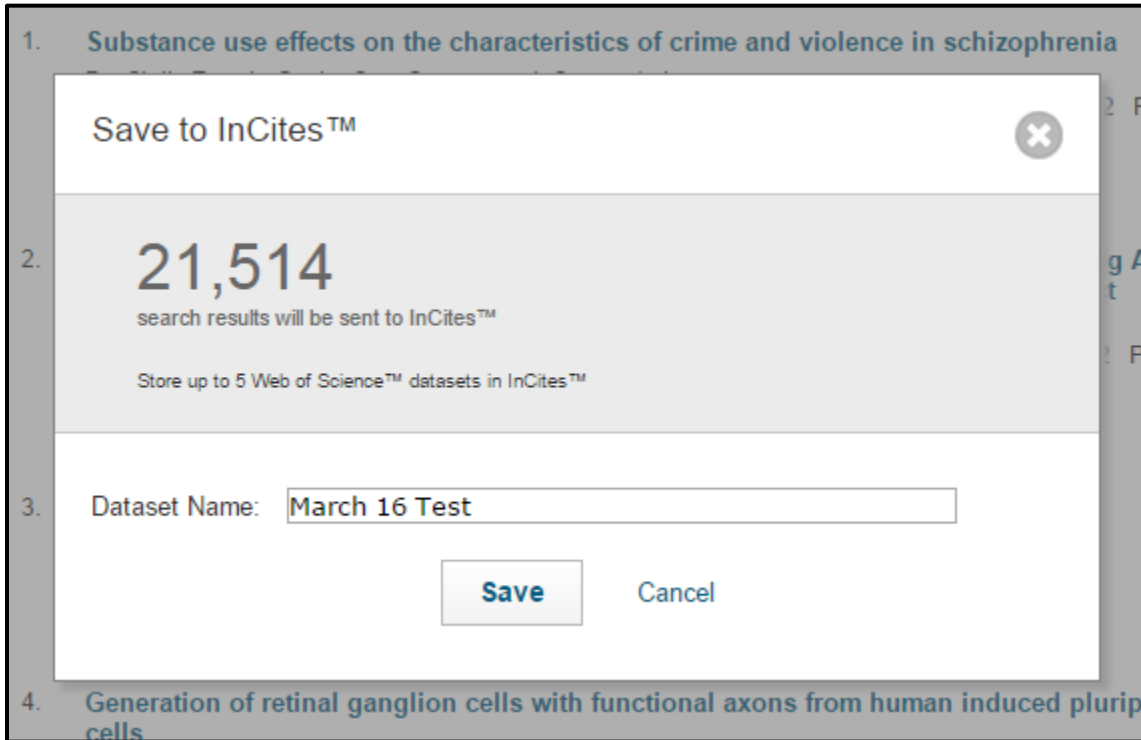

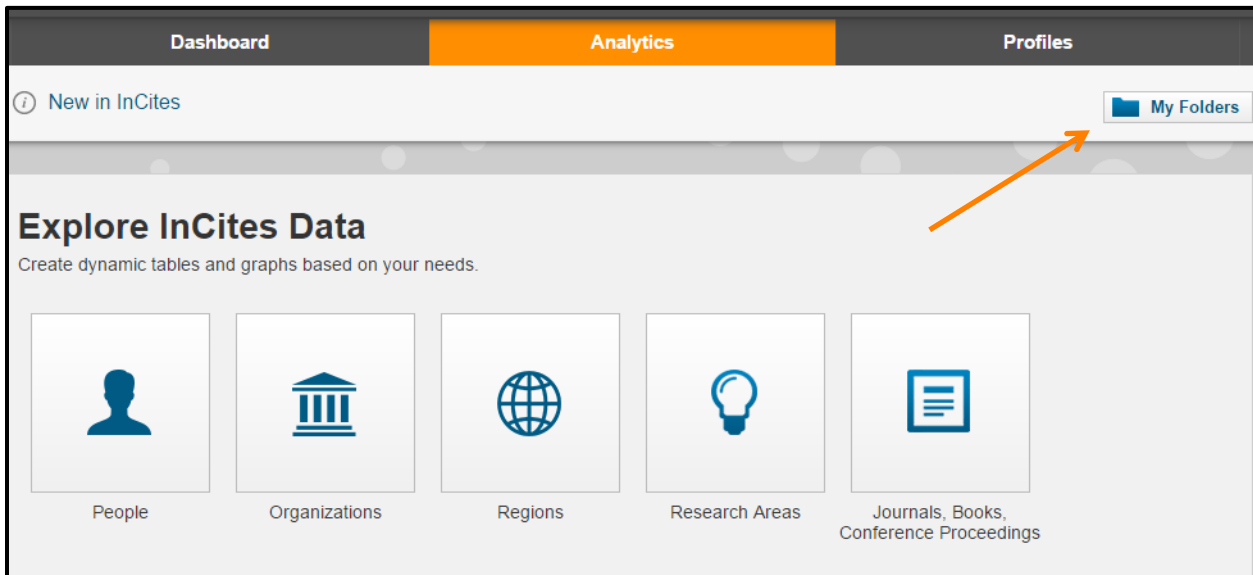

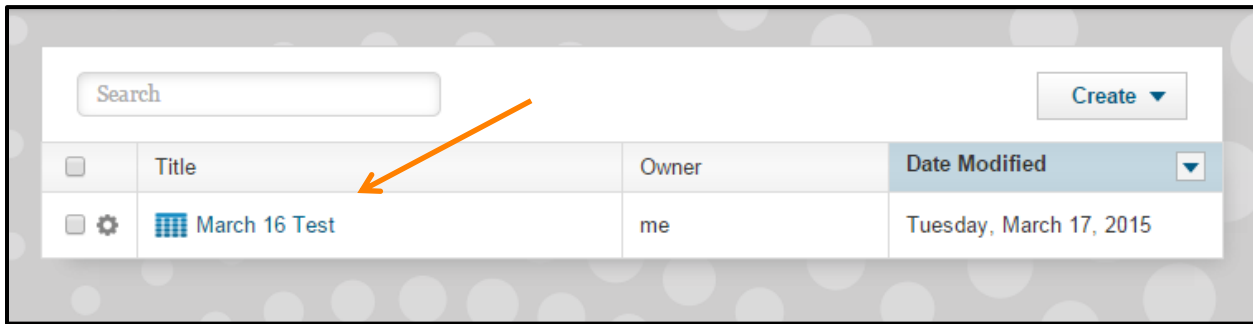

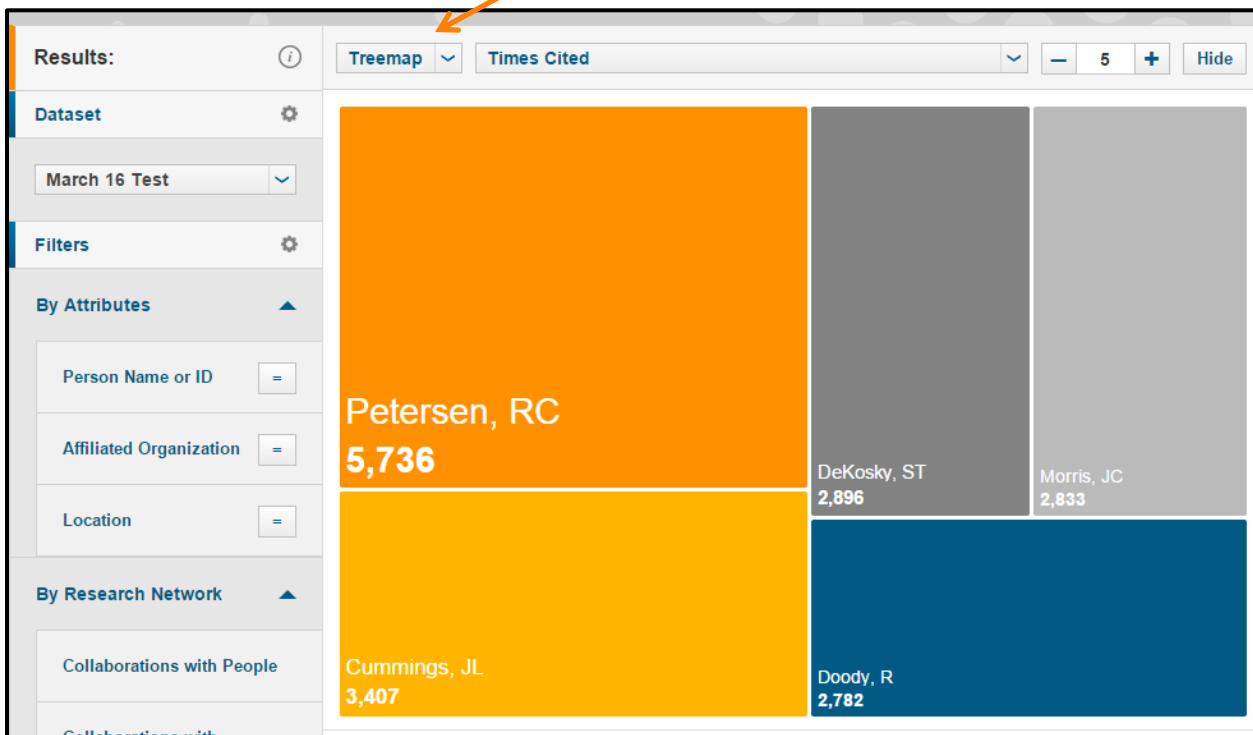
